

Monthly Summary

Monthly summary for the Cabinet for the month of January, 2019 in respect of Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (Divyangjan):-

1. On the occasion of 'National Girl Child Day' on 24.01.2019, Hon'ble Minister, Social Justice and Empowerment inaugurated the Eco Tourism Garden, at National Institute for the empowerment of Persons with Visually Disabilities, Dehradun. Hon'ble Minister also released large print and audio version of 'Hanumaan Chalisa' with QR Code, New Year Diary and Visiting Card in universal format on this occasion.
2. Pt. Deendayal Upadhyaya National Institute for Persons with Physical Disabilities (PDUNIPPD), New Delhi coordinated the participation of 80 Divyang children from various Institutions/NGOs in Republic Day Celebration 2019.
3. Hon'ble Minister of State for Social Justice & Empowerment inaugurated the vertical extension of academic building-library and classrooms of Composite Regional Centre, Guwahati on 10th January, 2019. He also attended National Conference on 'Disability and Social Inclusion the role of technology' held on 10th-11th January, 2019 in collaboration with IIT-Guwahati.
4. The Department organized a Regional Conference on Deendayal Disabled Rehabilitation Scheme (DDRS) on 17th January, 2019 at Nehru Centre, Mumbai with the objective of sensitizing all Program Implementing Agencies who are running the projects under DDRS and to familiarize them with the revised norms of the scheme. The conference was attended by about 200 participants including representatives from NGOs, District & Social Welfare officers and other State Govt. officials.
5. Under the scheme of Assistance to Disabled Persons for Purchase /Fitting of Aids and Appliances (ADIP), in the month of January, 2019, the following special camps were held at 21 locations in the country for distribution of aids and assistive devices to Divyangjan as indicated below:

6. The Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI) registered 417 Professionals and 260 Personnel in the Central Rehabilitation Register. The Council granted 50 and 02 Continuing Rehabilitation Education (CRE) programmes/short-term Training Programmes without and with financial assistance respectively.

Chief Commissioner of Persons with Disabilities (CCPD) received 131 cases and disposed of 198 cases (including backlog) in the month of January, 2019.

7. National Institute of Locomotor Disabilities (NILD), Kolkata served 1839 new cases and 2398 follow up beneficiaries and 43 Aids distributed in a camp organized by the institute in month of January, 2019.
8. National Institute of Empowerment of Persons with Visually Disabilities (NIEPVD), Dehradun served 4969 new cases and 10670 follow up beneficiaries and 5776 no of follow up services served in various clinical and other services in month of January, 2019.
9. National Institute of Empowerment of Persons with Multiple Disabilities (NIEPMD), Chennai served 625 new cases and 4813 follow up beneficiaries and 9926 no of follow up services served in various clinical and other services in month of January, 2019. Institute with collaboration with SRM institute of Schiene and Technology, Chennai organized the State Level Conference on Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016: Implications for Persons with Disabilities at SRM Medical College Hospital & Research Centre, Kaatungaluthur, Chennai on 23-24th January, 2019.
10. Swami Vivekanand National Institute of Rehabilitation Training and Research (SVNIRTAR) served 3871 new cases and follow up cases served were 1487 during the month of January, 2019. Institute conducted an assessment-cum-distribution camp at Mother Teresa Home, Janla, Jhurda, Odisha on 16th January, 2019. And surgical camp held at CRC, Guwahati from 9th and 10th January carried out 25 surgeries.
11. Ali Yavar Jung National Institute of Speech & Hearing Disabilities (AYJNIHH), Mumbai served 2789 new cases and 26011 follow up cases and conducted four camps throughout the country benefitting 534 persons out of which 219 persons with hearing impairment were distributed 384 hearing aids in the month of January, 2019.
12. The National Handicapped Finance and Development Corporation (NHFDC) disbursed loan of Rs. 561.09 lakhs to 479 beneficiaries during the month of January, 2019. During the month, Rs. 96.25 lakhs were sanctioned for skill training of 878 persons with disabilities and 10 stalls were allotted to Surajkund Mela, Faridabad benefitting 20 beneficiaries form various States/UTs on 31th January, 2019 to enable them to sale/exhibit their products and goods.
